## International Symposium on Mixing in Industrial Processes - ISMIP 6

*Aug 17-21, 2008  
Niagara Falls, Ontario, Canada*

### Conference Background

The first ISMIP conference was held in 1996, Quebec City and have been held in cities across the Globe since: Cancun, Osaka, Toulouse and Seville. The conferences focus have centered on bringing together the global fluid mixing community across academia, industry, private and governmental research institutions to share and discuss the latest research developments. A key goal for these conferences has been to highlight research that has industrial relevance and/or applications.

### Conference Objectives

The key objective for ISMIP 6 will be to foster connections across the broader mixing community with specific objectives to bring experts from various industrial application areas to share their work and challenges. Key industrial areas targeted at this meeting will be: *polymers / plastics, natural resources (mining, energy, water, etc.), food and consumer goods*. A second goal is to help showcase research through plenary and invited presentations that help bridge areas of expertise to highlight the gaps in the literature and research needs in the field of fluid mixing. Specifically, the conference aims to showcase research that is centered at the interfaces where physical chemistry, material properties (rheology) and fluid mixing hydrodynamics are crucial to the success of industrial processes.

### Conference Location

The conference will be held near a global natural wonder of the world: Niagara Falls in Canada. The conference venue will be the White Oaks resort, which is a dedicated conference venue focusing on enabling the highest quality conferences.

### Submission Process for Papers

The conference plans to publish the papers from the conference in a special issue of a Scientific Journal (Chem Eng Sci (TBD)). Authors will be given the option to submit a paper to be considered for journal publication and presentation or submit an extended abstract for conference proceedings and presentation.
